

- First 10 WGs completed their mandates
- Second wave of WGs launched in Sep. 2025
- Consensus-building around outputs via endorsement (first Type B output endorsed and first Type A output under review)

Cascade Funding projects catalyse reform & institutional change




- 1st wave of CF project to be completed in Dec. 2025

CoARA membership: a growing global coalition



Action Plans: building blocks for advancing reform

- Action Plans play a vital role in fulfilling the core commitments of the CoARA Agreement, helping signatories and members outline key milestones for implementing research assessment reform
- Upon signing the Agreement, organisations commit to developing an Action Plan within one year.
- While organisations have full freedom in the development of their Action Plans, we understand that the one-year timeframe may be challenging for some to achieve.
- Resources currently available: FAQs, guidelines, webinars, Zenodo community, drop-in sessions with the CoARA Steering Board (launched in 2025)
- More support to come in 2026: guidance based on AP drop-in sessions, searchable database currently in development, and more...














Working Groups address key topics central to responsible research assessment

- > To exchange, pilot, and implement new practices, processes and tools










Cascade Funding Call








CiviCRM: open source constituent relationship management tool
