Report from the past year

- Have held five on-line meetings
- Started by taking stock of the knowledge in the group and how bibliometrics is used for evaluation of research, by participating universities.
- Shared our experiences with each other, starting with oral presentations and then summarizing this in a written report.
- Information from SUHF expert group working group in Bibliometrics





Main learnings and take-aways so far

- Different flavour of usage of bibliometric methods at Swedish universities
- Different conditions for different scientific fields
- Usage at group level, not evaluation of reseaerchers
- New needs of sources for bibliometric analyses
- Ongoing work with classification of journals beside the Norwegian list





Plan for the coming year

- Collaboration with SUHF WG on bibliometrics
 - Implementation of principles for responsible use bibliometrics
- Collaboration with other WGs in CoARA Sweden

- Provide direct input to CoARA for continuous development
 - On usage of bibliometrics in relation ro peer reveiw
 - Develop desciption of responsible metrics
